24 Monday MI has established a weekly meeting with our **interns** to review their work ethic and ministry. Ronald is in the church office and doing the TPC; Tonny is doing the TPC and administrative work in connection with it; Manases is also doing the TPC and spending time evangelizing; Connor is visiting from Canada for a few months.

25 Tuesday We thank the Lord for the provision of finances for the various needs in **Pokot North**. It is a lesson we are so slow to learn, that the Lord provides for the work He wants to get done, although we have seen it year after year. We earnestly desire that this provision will be a means of spreading the gospel and an indication he Lord will truly bless.

26 Wednesday Our final visit in Rendille was to **Losidan** where we sponsor a school. The Government has sent a young married lady to this remote place and she says she is happy to devote herself to such needy children. 27 Thursday At **Lontolio** we called on Stephen who is seeking to plant a Baptist Church. 29 Saturday Pray for the 6 **Deacons** of TBC Nairobi. Our working relationship has greatly improved and we thank the Lord for all they are doing. They have a big and demanding task encompassing, not only the church in Nairobi, but churches related to us throughout the country, many of which they have no personal knowledge.

30 Sunday Today in Nairobi MI is leading the Adult Sunday School on Distinctive Doctrines and **preaching** in the morning service, and Dominic Kabaria is preaching in the afternoon service.

31 Monday Please continue to remember **MI** in prayer. With EA on Sabbatical he is effectively alone, although Skyping with KU is helpful. We have many gifted men in the church and we are seeking ways to help them to grow in possible preparation for future leadership in the church.
