Despite the difficulties we continue to see growing home churches and fellowship groups with over many new believers confessing and repented from their sin and then to believe our Lord Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour!

We face hardship days ahead with the severe drought in lowland in HOA countries, particularly pastoralist communities area. It is a great test of our people's faith, many fear for their lives after we lost few keys active figures in October 14, 2017 bomb blast in Zobe hotel in Mogadishu city centre. Please pray for me with the MERF team and other fellows from indigenous Missioners are working above and underground inland of Somali that we would keep our eyes and seeking first His Kingdom righteousness! as we run the race for His glory.

Kenya Trip:

I have had got 10 days privilege trip to visited TBC home church in Nairobi for three major reasons:
