KORR REPORT

EVANGELIST. The three evangelists that is Joseph Ogom, Godana Dabalen and Rugayon Nadesol do the evangelism to the goobs every Tuesday and Friday, where on Tuesday they visit goobs that are far and on Friday they visit the nearby villages (goobs). On Wednesday the church meet for bible study starting at 3pm to 4pm. On Thursday it is meant for prayers, church meet to pray together at 3pm to 4pm. On Saturday the Church elders meet for the preparation for Sunday. They prepare for Sunday schools and sermon, public reading and prayers. On Sunday the duty for teaching Sunday school and Sermon is done by Ogom and Godana interchangeably each Sunday's and Public reading is mostly done by Youths while the Prayers are done by Nadesol.

YOUTH. We are glad that the youth in korr were able to meet together and able to work with the church hand in hand for the purpose of the gospel. During their previous meeting they discussed about the challenges they are facing that lowers their zeal to serve God and help the church. The meeting was successful and they find out that one of the challenge is idealness and much waste of time without doing anything. Another challenge that was raised was that most youth go to other institutions for search of jobs and some end up Joining that institutions that offers them job. Another challenge was that lack of accountability for each other past years. After the long discussion, they decided to make time to meet each holidays, and they propose to meet every Tuesday which they all agreed on during the holidays. The saved Youth were given responsibility to teach others on the word of God and also they are going to be given time to teach Sunday school and help in memory verses. The youth also decided to help the elders in the work of evangelism. While I was home I got the privilege of attending two of their meeting and I find them useful and encouraging I pray that God will continue using the youths in His ministry.

LADIES. I haven't got much time to interact with ladies in the church. They are meeting every Saturday from 3pm to 4pm to encourage each other in the Lord. They also help in serving the church during special events like Christmas and New Year and they also provide services for guests by preparation of the rooms before the guests arrive. They are very helpful.

MEMBERS. We thank God that the numbers of members is increasing. The current number of members is 16. We are praying that the Lord will bring many more to His Kingdom.

CHURCH FACILITIES. The new building is currently used as a meeting place on Sundays and week days.

The church is in shortage of Rendille Hymn books and the few literate members have no Swahili bibles to read along with the preacher. The chairs are in good condition as they are kept in the guest room. The mattresses and beds are also well maintained. The evangelists are so pleased with the motorcycle they got. They have already started using it.

RECOMMENDATIONS

EVANGELISTS. The evangelists are doing well in the ministry but they lack teaching facilities, especially now as the youths are also joining the elders in the evangelism work. I

recommend the church to be provided with books, bibles (swahili). The Rendille Bible will be released this year according to the information I got. It will be of great help if the church in Korr will get some copies for easy spread of the gospel to illiterate people.

YOUTH. We thank God for bringing the youth together, as we look forward to do the purposes of God for His Glory. Due to the much time wasting among the youths as a challenge I will recommend to be assisted with more reading materials so as we can keep each others accountable as we encourage one another in the Lord. Reading will help us to know more about scripture and glorify God in our lives. I also recommend the youths in Korr to be engaged in any job opportunities that might come up within the church compound for example the ongoing construction. This will help youth to stick to the church.

CONCLUSIONS

In conclusion the church in Korr is growing and doing well in the Lord Jesus Christ. We are requesting for your prayers always, as we preach the gospel to the Rendille people.
