Pray that the Lord will provide an honest surveyor and that this process will be completed soonest.

26 Wednesday (1) Please continue to pray for the work in **Katilu**, especially that the Lord may bring many sinners to faith in Christ and for the Lord of the harvest to increase his labourers for his cause to work alongside Isaac Erot. (2) Would you earnestly pray for Joshua Karani and the work he leads at **Faith Reformed Baptist** church in Nairobi over the need for more gospel workers?

27 Thursday May the Lord smile upon the prayers of his saints today as we gather over Zoom to pray. Thursday **prayer meetings** have been a source of great encouragement to prayer. Our prayer is that the Lord will increase and strengthen our prayers so that we can pray even more for His kingdom to come.

28 Friday MI is planning to **visit the US** in September to thank those who pray and financially support the work, and to encourage more interest in the gospel work as well as strengthen Christian ties. He hopes to travel with his wife Charity. They plan to attend RBNet's Annual General Assembly in Jackson, Mississippi.

May the Lord give him the grace to powerfully expound the Scriptures aided by the Holy Spirit so that Christ's church may be built.

1 Saturday The **Passion for Missions** Conference was disrupted by the third wave of Covid infections. The Keynote speaker, Osinachi Nwoko, came but the messages were livestreamed. Over 300 views on the livestreaming platforms were recorded and after the preached messages were edited and sent out there were more online views. We pray that the Lord may kindle a new desire for the saints to faithfully bear the flaming torch of the gospel wherever the Lord has placed them.

2 Sunday Ministry today: The three Elders are doing a Table Talk, responding to various questions about the Christian view of the civil magistrate. MI preaches in the morning from Romans 3:13-18 while DK preaches in the afternoon from 1 Samuel 15 as he continues to take us through the life and ministry of Samuel. We shall premier at 2 p.m. episode 17 of the Spurgeon's Stories for Children.

MI planned to be in Pokot, and to have visited Teka in Kitale and Isaac Erot in Katilu, Turkana, but the lockdown has been extended for 30 more days.

17 Monday The church in Korr was greatly affected by the circumcision season so that the attendance hit the lowest and the evangelistic work to different *goobs* (villages) was hindered. But thank God that normalcy has returned and the fellowship is warmer. May we never tire of beseeching the Lord to shine the light of the gospel among the **Rendille** people group.

18 Tuesday The **RBAK** general assembly is scheduled to take place in Nairobi from 7th to 10th October. Please pray for the strengthening of this national Association as we seek like-minded churches to join up so that we can have a united gospel front being such a reformed Baptist community in the country. We also desire that the Lord will open a door for it to be registered with the Registrar of Societies.

19 Wednesday The **Kiswahili Service** was disrupted because MI was away in Meru. Previous messages were replayed. Nonetheless, the Lord is able to use even the old messages to edify his saints and to save his elect. MI began a series of teachings on *Holy Spirit: His Person and Work* from 28th April.

20 Thursday (1) The church in **Vote** is still in need of your prayers both for growth – both spiritually and numerically and for additional church leaders. (2) The church in **Kima** has also struggled to find another man to replace Francis Maundu who passed on and who was one of the deacons.
