- 25 Thursday The churches in the **coast**al part of Kenya are TBC Boyani (George Mwanjisi); and 3 in Mombasa, Gospel Missions Agency (Barnabas Olare), Christ Bible Church (Mustafa Abubakar) and Utakaso Bible Church (Ibrahim Katana, a TPC student). It is an area of Kenya where Islam is strong, although with an underlying folk religion.
- 26 Friday Nickson Teka continues to work hard with the help of his wife Martha and brother Tito Sitati in planting a reformed congregation in **Kitale**. People have been coming and going but they have had consistent ministry every Sunday. The Lord has also opened up doors for them in a street children rehabilitation centre, a police station and among college students.

Some have gladly stayed and sadly others have not. We pray that the new additions will continue to motivate us to plant more new churches across the city.

Ryan Devine is stepping down from the Board and we desire to have a replacement. We have big strategic adjustments to make in the coming days.
- 3 Wednesday The first meeting of the new church plant took place on the 31<sup>st</sup> July. The name of the church is Grace Reformed Baptist (GRBC), **Ruiru**. Over 20 TBC members who live in this general area are committed to form the church. We hope that by the end of August we shall be able to see clearly the way forward.
